Instructions for making your Sheep: (see image below)

- 1. Cut out Sheep and ear
- 2. Put child's name on the back of the sheep.
- 3. Use Elmer's glue to stick the cotton balls to the lamb. Do not cover the face of the lamb with cotton balls.
- 4. Allow to dry completely.
- 5. Glue the ear on top of the cotton balls on sheep's head
- 6. Some students like to add a paper hat or bow to the top of the head or a tie, ribbon, or bow to the neck. (Please, NO glitter)
- 7. Return your sheep AS SOON AS IT IS COMPLETED.

Holy Trinity School students, make sure the student's name is visible on the back and please place your completely dried sheep back into its Ziploc bag. Return your sheep to your school teacher.

Youth Faith Formation students, make sure the student's name is visible on the back and place your completely dried sheep back into its Ziploc bag. Return your sheep to your YFF Catechist or to the Holy Trinity Parish Office.

ALL SHEEP MUST BE RETURNED AS SOON AS COMPLETED.

We need time to attach a green stand to the back of each one before the Reconciliation Service. Students will get their sheep as they enter church for the Reconciliation Service and place it at the feet of a 6 ft. tall cutout of Jesus standing at the altar. After making their confession and praying the penance, if you would like, you may take a photo of your child holding his/her sheep near Jesus, and students may take their sheep home.
