<u>Confirmation Sponsor</u> - who is your sponsor, how are you acquainted/related, why did you select him/her, how does he/she inspire you and support you to live a life of faith <u>And Service Works</u> - share the details of any service experiences you participated in, what did you learn about living your faith, how did it feel to help others, sacrifice your own time and effort, share your gifts and abilities, was it easy or hard, what does it inspire you to do next for others, how did it challenge you or affirm you, what did you learn about yourself from these experiences

You may need a separate paragraph for each of those three topics or a couple of those topics might fit into one paragraph.
